Hoopeston Area High School graduates 67 in Class of 2007

Amid tears, smiles and whistles, Hoopeston Area High School graduated the Class of 2007 Friday evening.

It was a time to look forward and back, as student leaders talked about their years together and the future that lays ahead of them, and a time to remember those no longer here, as Principal Hank Hornbeck called to mind former Superintendent Mark Conolly and teacher and Coach Dan Park, who died during the school year.

Assembled families and friends heard from class officers, including Anabell Torres, Steven Taylor and Jacqueline Vicari, as well as the class' brightest students, valedictorian Brandy Jo Patterson, salutatorian Reid Walder and Rossville-Alvin High School salutatorian Whitley Huff.

Walker told graduates that the direction their lives would go is up to them. Quoting Dr. Seuss, he said, "You have brains in your head, you have feet in your shoes. You can steer yourself any direction you chose."

Huff, who attended Hoopeston Area after Rossville-Alvin High School deactivated, said "I love everything about this school. I never thought I'd be anything but a Bobcat but now I know that nothing fits me better than the title of Hoopeston Cornjerker."

The school's mixed chorus sang "100 Years," bringing tears to the eyes of several senior girls.


