Rossville announces annual town cleanup day guidelines

ROSSVILLE—Guidelines for the annual all-town cleanup day were distributed at Monday night's village board meeting.

For previous cleanup days, residents set unwanted items out for pickup.

This year, however, to keep costs down, residents are asked to take items to a central location.

Dumpsters will be at the village maintenance area from 8 a.m.-4 p.m. Saturday, June 9. The site will be open only to Rossville residents and a village employee will be on-site to make sure unacceptable items are not put in dumpsters.
