

The lab has been relocated, redecorated and, most importantly, it received updated equipment, including a

\$75,000 piece of equipment that will allow lab employees to more quickly analyze samples and get results to physicians.

"I've been waiting 32 years for this," said Rankin, smiling broadly.

The new lab will help employees better handle the more than 85,000 samples that must be checked each year, including microbiology tests. HRHC is the only hospital in Vermilion County that does its own microbiology, allowing patients and doctors to get results in a

more timely fashion.

The lab is not the only thing new at the health center. Walls that were formerly a shade of orange have been painted a more muted color, while new flooring brightens the halls. New signage directs patients to lab and x-ray areas and new furniture graces the emergency room waiting room.

The front entrance of the hospital is being moved and in the near future, the registration desk will be moved to accommodate remodeling, said CEO David Elliott.

Changes are not only happening on the inside. Outside, the nursing home flower garden has been expanded to include more plants and flowers and a fountain. The garden is secured by a brick wall to help keep nursing home residents safe.

Also, the facility has changed its heat source, from boilers to hot water tanks that circulate heat through the building.
