Charges filed in suspected overdose death of Hoopeston man

Almost one month ago, family and friends whooped and cheered as John Morgenroth received his diploma from Hoopeston Area High School.

Those same family and friends are now mourning his death.

Mr. Morgenroth, 18, was found unresponsive Wednesday morning at his home in the 300 block of East Washington.

He was pronounced dead by a Vermilion County coroner at 9:48 a.m., said Coroner Peggy

Johnson. "We suspect the death can be attributed to an overdose," she said in a written statement.

Toxicology reports are pending and an inquest will be held at a later date. No autopsy was scheduled.

Hoopeston police were called to the scene by ambulance personnel, according to a written statement issued by Police Chief Mark Drollinger.

Local police and the Vermilion County Sheriff's department Investigation Division began an investigation into the incident which resulted in the arrest of Thomas Dalton, 20, of Hoopeston.

Dalton faces preliminary charges of drug induced homicide, a Class X felony, and delivery of a controlled substance.

He was taken to the Public Safety Building in Danville where he was held in lieu of bond.

Dalton is currently on probation for a 2005 burglary to which he pleaded guilty last year.
