## Local area sinks into deep freeze, cold to continue Friday

It's been said if you don't like Illinois weather, wait five minutes and it will change.

That's not true with the deep freeze conditions currently across much of the state. At 5:30 a.m. Thursday, the local temperature was -11 and the forecast does not call for an increase above zero until Friday afternoon.

Schools in Vermilion and Iroquois counties were closed Thursday, with many officials making the decision the night before.

Hoopeston Area utilized the AlertNow system allowing Superintendent Hank Hornbeck to make the announcement at about 6:30 p.m. Wednesday.

A wind chill warning remains in effect for the area until noon Friday. Thursday night's low was expected to be -17, with winds of eight to 11 miles per hour and wind chill values of -27 to -32.

Even with a high of 10 and a low of 6 on Friday, and winds of seven to 10 miles per hour, wind chills are estimated to be -21 to -31 during the day and -3 to -13 at night.

Saturday's forecast calls for warmer temperatures, with a high of 24 and a chance of snow.

The area is not expected to crawl out of the ice box until Wednesday.
