City water rates to increase to fund storage tank repairs

Hoopeston residents could see a \$2.88 increase in water rates to repay a \$1.25 million loan to fix city water storage tanks.

The council unanimously approved a resolution allowing Mayor Bill Crusinberry to sign loan documents. When the loan is granted, residents will see as much as a \$2.88 per month hike in water fees. Crusinberry said.

If the city receives federal stimulus money for part of the project costs, the planned increase will decrease by one-third or about \$1 per month, he said.

Residents may override the council's decision with a petition signed by 10 percent of registered voters who participated in the April election, said city attornev Paul Manion.

The increase for loan repayment is the first of planned increases in water rates. Last month, Alderman Bill Goodwine, finance committee chairman, said rates would have to be examined to keep the water/sewer department from depleting reserve funds.

After Tuesday's meeting, Crusinberry concurred that rates would have to be raised for that reason, but said that increase would be a percentage, not a flat amount, and will not be implemented until July or later.
