# Entries sought for Rossville sesquicentennial parade Aug. 8

ROSSVILLE—The Village of Rossville will be celebrating its sesquicentennial August 5-9. One of the highlighted events will be the official Sesquicentennial Parade. Organizers hope area residents and business will join in with their own floats, cars, bicycles, horses, buggies or golf carts for the parade.

"Anyone is welcome to be in the parade," said Sesquicentennial Chairman Kevin Young. "We hope families, neighborhoods, businesses and individuals will take part in the parade. After all, you only have a sesquicentennial parade once in a 150 years."

The parade will start at 4 p.m. Saturday August 8.

Among the featured units in the parade will be the Fountain Trust Pipe Band, the Tippecanoe Fife and Drum Corps, and a contingent of the world famous Arcola Lawn Rangers.

The Hoopeston Area High School band will also be in the parade. "We are very pleased that our friends in Hoopeston are joining in," Young said. "Their band committed very early to being here, and with many of our student attending there, it shows a great joint community spirit."
