Hoopeston Area schools announce 2009-10 year registration

Hoopeston Area schools have set registration dates and times for the 2009-10 school year.

Registration will begin Tuesday, Aug. 11 for high and middle school students. Times are 8:20-11 a.m. and 1-3:30 p.m.

Wednesday, Aug. 12, students CARE, ECSE and grades kindergarten to 6 (Maple, Honeywell and John Greer) will register from 1-6 p.m. at the middle school.

Special registration assistance will also be available for migrant families on Wednesday. Look for the Migrant Education table.

Middle and high school registration will also be held Wednesday, from 1-6 p.m.

Registration forms are available on the school website, www.hoopeston.k12.il.us. Forms may be completed, printed and taken to registration to speed up the process. Supply lists for students at Maple, Honeywell and John Greer are also available on the website.

The list will also be printed in an upcoming issue of Just the Facts.

Orientation for incoming freshmen will be held at 6



p.m. August 12 in the high school auditorium.

Kindergarten orientation will be held from 6-7 p.m. Tuesday, Aug. 18. Kindergarten students and parents should go directly to the lunchroom. School supplies should be brought to orientation.

The middle school will hold an open house at 6 p.m. Thursday,

Aug. 20.

Fees for the year are \$25 for early childhood and \$50 for grades kindergarten-12.

Middle/high school extracurricular fee is \$20 per activity with a maximum of \$40 per student or \$80 per family.

Additionally, all driver's education students must pay \$50 for classroom/behind the wheel instruction. Spanish I students will owe \$10 for a workbook.

State requirements are that all kindergarten, sixth and ninth grade students must have health physicals before the start of school on August 21.

Student athletes will be required to have a sports physical to be able to participate in sports activities.
