HRHC shows off Bridgeway program to area residents

On August 19, residents and visitors to Hoopeston got the opportunity to tour the newly renovated Bridgeway building (formerly Drollinger Insurance). Bridgeway is a new department of the Hoopeston Regional Health Center that specializes in outpatient behavioral health for senior adults. It provides needed mental health services that, up until now, have not been offered close to home for many people.

During tours of the building, guests learned how this new program is run. The program consists of individual therapy sessions, in combination with various group meetings. When people are referred to the program, they receive an initial screening at their home or in the Bridgeway offices, if preferred. If it is then determined that the person needs this service, Dr. Thomas Herrmann, MD., performs a complete evaluation; from there he determines whether it is appropriate for the person to join Bridgeway.

Bridgeway's main criteria for referral are that an individual is willing and able to participate in the group ses-

sions, and are able to retain the information they attain through this program.

The open house gave the community the opportunity to not only explore the renovations, but also meet the staff. Heidi McGill, Bridgeway Program Director, was on hand to provide information on this new service, along with her co-workers Jessica Nemezc and Virginia Maggio.
