City officials plan to crack down on abandoned houses

Hoopeston officials hope to crack down on abandoned buildings and out-of-town owners who fail to keep up their buildings.

At Tuesday's Hoopeston City Council meeting, Alderwoman Susan Comstock, chairman of the civic improvement committee, had "probably 20 pictures" of empty houses with no utility service to them. All have been vacant for at least one year and many for more years. One house has a tree growing in the middle of it and has been that way for several years, she said.

Comstock has been working with compliance officer John Holt and city attorney Paul Manion to come up

with solutions. She has set a civic committee meeting for 6:30 p.m. September 10 at Hoopeston City Hall. Manion and Holt plan to attend and the public is invited.

"We, as a city, have got to do something now," she said. "We will go aggressively after out-of-town owners who don't take care of their property.

In other business, Vista volunteer Jean Minick is looking for volunteers to conduct an income survey in Hoopeston. Training will be held at 10 a.m. September 10 at city hall. Volunteers will then go throughout the city conducting short interviews. The results of the survey will allow the city to receive infrastructure grants.

The Hybrids did good, too, especially among them Super Sonic and Burpee Big Early. Some new ones, like Gurney Girl and Burgermaster, I'd grow in a minute.

Maybe the biggest news is how we've become a tomato show, well over 100, with a nice big "garden" show growing all around it. There were peppers of all kinds, colors and sizes, onions, green beans, cantaloupe, watermelon, beets potatoes, carrots, leeks and even celery.

The home canned vegetables and homemade jams, jellies, relishes and that delicious and popular newcomer, salsa. Who wants to be a "tasting" judge next year?
