Cornjerkers climb all over Schlarmann Hilltoppers

After a year-long drought in the win column, Hoopeston Area's Cornjerkers rained on the Schlarmann Hilltoppers at Friday's Homecoming game.

A 58-yard rush from Zach Thrasher, who had 90 on the night, started Hoopeston's scoring drive. A 26-yard


score in the second and eight-yard run in the third by Cody Eells led to the 21-7 win for the Cornjerkers.

The win was the first Homecoming win for the team since 1993 and ended a dry streak that began after the
