John Greer School awarded field trip grant to museum

John Greer Elementary School students will have a new field trip to look forward

The school was one of 28 awarded a field trip grant to the Abraham Lincoln Presidential Museum in Springfield.

A donation from Midwest Generations, an Edison International Company, to the library foundation lets schools and groups serving lowincome vouth to visit the museum.

This is the fourth consecutive year Midwest Generation has contributed \$20,000 to the museum's foundation to allow classes and youth groups to tour the Abraham Lincoln Presidential Museum.

Teachers in Illinois schools that have lowincome enrollment of more than 30 percent are eligible to apply for the grant. Nonprofit agencies serving economically disadvan-

taged youth are also eligible to apply. Admission fees are waived and grants may be used to pay costs generally associated with a class or organization field trip.

Grant requests—106 totaling more than \$260.000—were received.
