Health department H1N1 vaccine clinic off to slow start

People arrived at the McFerren Park Civic Center before the 1 p.m. start of the Vermilion County Health Department's H1N1 vaccine clinic, but not in large numbers, at least early on.

The health department gave free vaccines to area residents from 1-7 p.m. Monday and Tuesday at the civic center.

Health department Linda Bolton hoped more people would come to the clinic after school let out, since one target group for the vaccine is young people aged six months to 24 years.

Early traffic was predominantly people with preschool aged children and senior citizens.

Based on Monday's turnout, staffing levels were to be evaluated for Tuesday's clinic, with perhaps fewer health department staff on the second day.

Earlier vaccine clinics at Southview Middle School and the health department office drew more than 2,100 and 1,152 people, respectively.

Vaccination clinics are being held for those most atrisk for H1N1, including pregnant women and nursing mothers, who must have a signed doctor's authorization; those who care for children under six months old; health care workers; all people ages ix months to 24 years; and people 25-64 with underlying health con-

cerns who would be adversely affected by H1NI.

Signs outside the civic center listed those eligible for the vaccine and asked others not in the specific categories to wait for open clinics, which will be held at a later date.

A second sign listed those who should not get the vaccine, including anyone with a fever, allergy to eggs, history of Guillain-Barre syndrome and those who previously had a serious adverse reaction to a flu shot.
