## Hoopeston Chamber to hold Christmas Festival Saturday

The Chamber of Commerce plans to throw a Christmas festival for the community on Saturday, December 5, 11 a.m. - 5 p.m. in downtown Hoopeston.

"We just want to bring the Christmas spirit back to the community and promote the idea of shopping locally," said Tami Goin, Chamber secretary.

Events planned for the day are:

- The Lorraine Theatre will host a free showing of "Polar Express" at 11 a.m. and 2 p.m. and hand out Christmas bells to children attending.
- Santa Claus' arrival is scheduled for 1 p.m. at the Methodist Church, 403 E. Main St.. He will remain there until 4 p.m., giving a small gift to each child. Photos with Santa will also be available at that time for \$3.
- The United Methodist Church will host a children's pajama contest from 1-4 p.m. with free cookies and hot chocolate being served.
- The final event of the day will be the lighting of Hoopeston's new 20-foot Giant Noble artificial Christmas tree at 5 p.m., complete with Christmas caroling around the tree. The tree will remain in Rotary Park throughout December.
