## Tuesday's primary draws four locals for county board seats

Four Hoopeston men are running for two available seats for District 1 of the Vermilion County Board in Tuesday's primary election.

Danny Lee Danner and Travis Taylor will be on the Democrat ballot and Republicans Todd Johnson and incumbent Gary Weinard are running on the Republican ballot for District 1.

Neither party has candidates running for precinct committeeman slots in Grant Township.

At the county level, Democrat incumbent Lynn Foster has no challengers. In the Republican primary, Dennis M. Miller is running unopposed.

Other county offices have no Democrats in the primary. Republicans include Sue Stine, treasurer; Pat Hartshorn, sheriff; Matthew R. Long, supervisor of assessments; and Cheryl S. Reifsteck, regional superintendent of schools.

In state races, voters have several choices for governor, including Republicans Kirk Dillard, Bill Brady, Robert Schillerstrom, Adam Andrezejewski, Dan Proft,

Jim Ryan and Andy McKenna and Democrats incumbent Pat Quinn and Daniel Hynes.

Lieutenant governor candidates include Democrats Arthur Turner, Terry Link, Rickey Hendon, Scott Cohen, Thomas Castillo and Mike Boland and Republicans Don Tracy, Jason Plummer, Randy White Sr., Brad Cole, Matt Murphy and Dennis W. Cook.

Attorney General candidates are Republican Steve Kim and, on the Democrat side, incumbent Lisa Madigan. Incumbent Secretary of State Jesse White is on the Democrat ballot, while Robert Enriquez is on the Republican ballot.

Republican candidates for comptroller include Judy Baar Topinka, Jim Dodge and William Kelly, and on the Democrat side, David Miller, S. Raja Krishnamoorthi and Clinton Krislov.

State treasurer candidates are Dan Rutherford, Republican, and Justin P. Oberman and Robin Kelly, Democrats.

Incumbent Shane Cultra is seeking another term in the legislature while on the Democrat side, David Gill is seeking his party's nomination.

In national contests, Democrats Robert Marshall, David Hoffman, Jacob Meister, Alexander Giannoulis and Cheryle Jackson are running for the senate, while on the Republican side, candidates include Donald Lowery, Mark Kirk, Andy Martin, Kathleen Thomas, John Arrington and Patrick Hughes.
