Trustees approved a resolution for oil and chip work in the village, for \$29,789.72 and Tax Increment Financing street work of \$17,671, said Mayor Terry Prillaman.

- Approving the zoning board's recommendation for a special use permit at 405 Holmes for an Illinois Department of Transportation field office.
