
Police News



County man dies in accident

A 39-year-old Danville man died in an accident just north of the Vermilion-Iroquois County line Wednesday night.

David L. Phillips was pronounced dead at 9:14 p.m. Wednesday at Hoopeston Community Memorial Hospital, according to Illinois State Police District 21 in Ashkum.

Phillips was northbound when he was allegedly hit by a 15-year-old girl who was westbound on County Line Road and reportedly failed to yield at Route 1.

According to police, the collision resulted in both vehicles going into a field. Phillips was ejected when his vehicle overturned.

The girl and a 17-year-old male passenger were also injured. She was airlifted to Carle Foundation Hospital, Urbana, while the boy was treated at Hoopeston Community Memorial Hospital.

Names of the girl and boy were not released by police.

The girl was ticketed for failure to yield, no driver's license and no insurance while the boy was cited for permitting an unauthorized person to drive.
