Hoopeston council members to review preliminary study

A preliminary study on the need for a motel in Hoopeston is being reviewed by the city council.

At Tuesday's Hoopeston City Council meeting, Mayor Bill Crusinberry asked aldermen to review the report and get back to him in the next week to 10 days with thoughts, comments and concerns.

The study, which indicates Hoopeston can support a 40-room motel, was done by TR Mandigo & Co., of Elmhurst.

Several people, including a representative of the Illinois Hotel/Motel Association and an Ameren construction representative, have already requested copies of the

report when it is finalized, Crusinberry said.

In other business, the council:

- Approved a bid from Rainwater Tree Service for cutting and topping trees, at \$145 each, and \$45 each for stump removal.
- Heard from Alderman Jeff Johnson that only sidewalks torn up as part of the North Market Street project will be replaced. Initial indications were that all sidewalks would be replaced but Johnson said that would put the project over budget.
- Approved Alexandria Rubio and John Carlson as auxiliary police members.


