Council approves rezoning for planned new nursing home

The Hoopeston City Council, on Tuesday, unanimously approved rezoning 25 acres of land for Hoopeston Regional Health Center's planned new nursing home.

The land, across from Anthem Chevrolet, was rezoned from agricultural to B1 commercial.

Bernie McCarthy, representing the health center, said construction will begin when the Department of Agriculture loan is received - expected in late August - and will take about 18 months to complete.

In unrelated business, the council:

- Heard from Chad Stephen of Second Chance with a request to close the alley behind the business, between Market

and Third St., on July 3. Mayor Bill Crusinberry, in his role as liquor commissioner, approved the request. The council could not vote on the request because the matter was left off the meeting agenda.

- Amended the garbage rate from \$12 to \$13 per month. The increase helped officials balance the city's budget.

- In a related matter, Crusinberry said residents are not yet required to use blue garbage totes for trash pickup.

- Heard from Jean Minick that the waiting list for Prairie Meadows is growing. Those on the list have started receiving applications, she said. Also, Infrastructure work has begun on the project.
