Foundation annual appeal results in new scope at hospital

Hoopeston Area Healthcare Foundation has purchased a new scope for the surgery department at Hoopeston Community Memorial Hospital. Funds for the scope came from the Foundation's Annual Appeal.

Misti Morfey, operating room nurse manager, said "the new ureterscope is a scope the urologists use to visualize inside the ureters, which is part of the urinary tract system. The scope can be used to diagnose problems and can also be used by the surgeon to treat certain conditions such as removal of a stone."

Morfey went on to say "the Foundation's generosity has enabled our surgeons to perform faster, more precise

procedures due to the vastly increased high definition visualization of the new scope." She also commented that surgery team members are excited about having this piece of equipment as it replaces one purchased several years ago and will help provide the best possible results for patients.
