Rossville trustees hear presentation on village website design

ROSSVILLE—Village trustees are interested in expanding Rossville's web presence and are looking for a web designer to make it happen.

At Monday's village board meeting, trustees heard from Steve Foster of BEAMSCO of Danville.

Foster told the board that a basic website could be designed for under \$1,100. Monthly hosting fees would range from \$18 to \$60 per month, depending on the bandwidth required for the site.

Foster, a Danville alderman and owner of the former Foster Aviation, said his company has been designing web pages for 11 years and, to date, has de-

signed about 250 in east central Illinois.

In unrelated action, the board approved a one-year contract with Health Alliance, using Crose Insurance Agency of Danville as its representative.

Although employees will continue to pay nothing for their health insurance, they will see a higher deductible, as the new plan increases the deductible from \$1,000 per year to \$1,500.

Under the plan, employees may choose from a preferred provide organization (PPO) plan, which would cost the village \$1,717 for the year, or a POS-C (point of service-C) plan at \$991 for a year.

The board also:

• Approved a special use permit for property about one-half mile north of the village, allowing Tower Access Group of Richmond, Ky., to build a 280-foot tower and building. The tower will be used by Cellular One for cell phone and wireless internet.

The tower is expected to be on air in 45 to 60 days.

• Approved hiring Mike Bray to install new siding and roofing at the pump house. The cost will be \$2,766 for siding and \$1,722 for metal roofing. Work will begin after Bray provides proof of insurance to the village.


