## Danville Area Community College sees increased attendance

DANVILLE—Officials at Danville Area Community College announced recently that College enrollment levels have increased once again.

The fall 2010 tenth-day enrollment figure for credit hours was almost 7 percent overall from the record-breaking numbers of fall 2009.

A nearly 4 percent increase was seen in total headcount, with about 4,000 students enrolled for fall.

"I have nothing but the highest praise for the DACC faculty, staff, administrators, and Board of Trustees for their willingness and ability to adjust to the changing needs of our community and to serve more students with minimal changes in staffing.

"This latest increase follows three previous semesters of record growth while funding levels have remained unchanged," said Dr. Alice M. Jacobs, DACC President.

"Community colleges educate 64% of the undergradu-

ate students in this country while receiving only 13% of higher education funding. The irony of our enrollment growth is that our state funding is less than we were receiving in 1997."



While the college is seeing its highest enrollment in nearly twenty years, officials want potential students to know there is always room for more.

Dr. Jacobs said, "One of the strengths of Danville Area Community College is its ability to accommodate non-traditional students and schedules. We realize that potential adult students, juggling work and family commitments, may find the start date of the traditional school year to be a bit too chaotic for their already hectic life.

"The college schedules late starting classes – classes which begin nearly a month later than traditional ones – to allow students to complete an entire semester's work in a shorter time period."
