At Tuesday's Hoopeston City Council meeting, Jean Minick said a motorcade of about 20 Model As will make the trip and are expected in Hoopeston at about 2 p.m. on Friday, Oct. 8. Group members hope to learn a bit about Hoopeston, then have pictures taken with the Hubbard Trail monument and sweet corn statue in the park, she said.
