## ‘Ghostly’ programs to be featured at Hoopeston library

The world of ghost hunting and paranormal activity will be featured in two upcoming programs at the Hoopeston Public Library.

At 6:30 p.m. Monday, Oct. 18, John Whitman, owner of the “Watseka Wonder,” also known as the Roff House, will be the featured speaker at the Hoopeston Historical Society meeting at the library.

The Illiana Paranormal Society returns to the library at 7 p.m. Tuesday, Oct. 19, to discuss their recent and upcoming investigations into the Roff House and also at Danville’s Fischer Theater.

The “Watseka Wonder” is the historic location

where American’s first document case of spiritual possession reportedly took place in 1877-1878. The home, build in 1868, was purchased by Whitman in 2005 and has been undergoing extensive renovation since that time.

At the October 19 program, D.J. Walker of the Illiana Paranormal Society, will present finds of his group’s recent program at the historic Watseka home, and will also discuss their upcoming “Ghost Walk” weekend events at the Fischer Theater.

The program is geared toward an audience of sev-

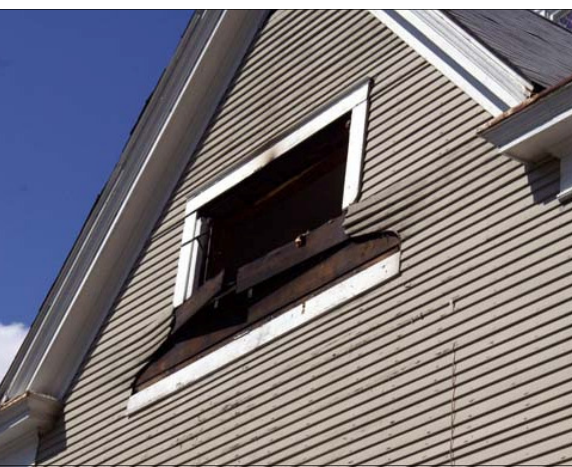

# Vermilion County Clerk's office announces extended hours for early, absentee voting

DANVILLE—Vermilion County Clerk Lynn Foster will offer extended hours for in-person absentee and early voting prior to the November 2 general election. The clerk's office conducts absentee and early voting for the 59 precincts located outside the city of Danville.

The voting center, located on the second floor of the Courthouse Annex, will be open from 9 a.m. until noon on Saturdays, October 2, October 9, October 16, October 23 and October 30.

Under a new provision in Illinois law, a voter who wishes to vote absentee need not declare a reason for doing so. Absentee voting is available in person or by mail.

Those wishing to vote absentee by mail should request an application from the County Clerk's office as soon as possible. Once the application is received, the clerk's office will mail a ballot. The last day on which an absentee ballot may be mailed to a voter is Thursday, Oct. 29. The application is also available online at [www.vercounty.org](http://www.vercounty.org).

Voters who are permanently disabled may request an application for a special identification card which will entitle them to automatically receive absentee ballot applications for every election for five years. The card is renewable. "This card is very convenient for our permanently disabled voters," Foster said. "We've had great
