An interception by Terrence Poke and subsequent 44-yard campaign put Hoopeston Area on the scoreboard first in Friday night's contest against the Salt Fork Storm. Unfortunately, it was the only scoring the Cornjerkers would do for the rest of the night. Storm defense held Poke to -5 yards rushing and held Robbie Irvin to 40 yards on 14 carries in Salt Fork's 31-6

Cornjerker defeat. The Cornjerkers had three turnovers on the night, including two fumbles and an interception. The loss puts the Cornjerkers at 2-4 overall and 2-2 in the Vermilion Valley Conference. Friday the team takes on the Bismarck-Henning Blue Devils at home.

Lady Cornjerkers spikers master G-RF, bow to Salt Fork

Hoopeston Area's volleyball team split two games last week, handily defeating Georgetown-Ridge Farm on Tuesday, but then falling to Salt Fork Thursday. Braddock led kills with five, followed by Weston with four and Jacy Samet, three. Braddock also had one block for the match. Zollar again led assists, with nine. In JV action, Salt Fork defeated Hoopeston Area, 25-21, 13-25, 15-13.
