Hoopeston council to get early start on garbage contract

Hoopeston's finance committee plans to get a head start on a new garbage contract.

The current contract with Vermilion Waste expires next March. However, regional manager Marty Grant requested an early start on negotiations to allow the company to get the information into its budget for next year.

Alderman Bill Goodwine, finance committee chairman, told council members that the city must first go out for bids on the service. Prior to the current contract, Vermilion Waste was the only company that submitted a bid. However, Goodwine said, another company may be

interested in providing the service now.

City officials will use the existing contract to draw up specifications before seeking bids, Goodwine said.

In unrelated business, the council:

- heard from Mayor Bill Crusinberry that most all terrain vehicles are not street-legal under the city's golf cart ordinance. However, he said, some ATVs are able to receive low-speed license plates under state ordinance. He reminded golf cart enthusiasts that the machines are allowed only on city streets where the speed limit is 25 m.p.h.
