# Voters today to consider amendment to state Constitution

Area voters will head to the polls today to cast their ballot for local, state and federal candidates, as well as vote on a proposed addition to the Illinois Constitution.

That measure, if passed, will amend the state Constitution to allow for a special election to recall a Governor and for a successor.

For the amendment to pass, either 60 percent of those voting on the question must vote yes or a majority of

those voting in the election must vote yes.

To start the process, a voter would file an affidavit stating an intention to circulate a petition to recall the governor. Such an affidavit may not be filed until the governor has served six months.

Ten member of the Illinois house and senate - half from Democrats and half from Republicans - must be on the affidavit.

> According to the Better Government Association, none of the 18 states that permit recalls require voters to get approval from lawmakers.

Petitioners must gather signatures equal to 15 percent of the number of voters in the previous gubernatorial election. In 2006, more than 3 million people voted in the governor's election. Of those signatures, a minimum of 100 must be from 25 different counties. After signatures are certified by the State Board of See VOTERS on other side





Elections, an election would be held no later than 100 days later. A majority of voters have to approve recalling the governor in order for him or her to be removed. The lieutenant governor then becomes acting governor until a special election is held. The line of succession includes the attorney general then secretary of state.

The special election would have to be held within 60 days of the recall.

According to the State Board of Elections, the tab for the recall election and special election would cost \$101 million.
