# Rutherford, Cultra show appreciation in local communities

State Senator Dan Rutherford and State Rep. Shane Cultra are touring communities in their districts to thank residents for their support as each man prepares for a new job.

In January, Rutherford will become state treasurer after winning the November election. Cultra was appointed to fill the remaining two years of Rutherford's Senate seat and Champaign County Republican chairman Jason Barickman has been named to fill Cultra's seat.

Few people turned out for the meet and greet in Hoopeston, but the result was different in Rossville, where Mayor Terry Prillaman joined residents in wishing the men well and thanking them for their help after a 2004 fire ting grants to benefit Rossville.

The two men's political lives have been tied together for years. First elected to the Illinois House in 1993, Rutherford worked with Cultra, who was then Iroquois County Board chairman. In 2003, Rutherford was elected to state senator for the 53rd District, and Cultra as the 105th District representative.

"I've known Dan a long time," Cultra said. "I was honored to follow him in the House and I'm blessed to follow him as state senator when he becomes treasurer."

Rutherford will resign his seat on January 9, 2011, followed by Cultra's swearing in at the state capitol in

Springfield. Rutherford will take his oath of office the following day.

Rutherford said Cultra's transition from representative to senator will be "seamless." Cultra already represents half of the Senate district and will attend events in the other half to get to know constituents.

There will be small differences for Cultra as he becomes senator, said Rutherford. Having held both positions, Rutherford said Cultra will be unable to attend as many local events as he did as representative because of

While Illinois is facing tough financial challenges, which concern its treasurer-elect, Rutherford couldn't help but find humor. "There's no money," he said. "I can do this job!"
