Petitions available for Hoopeston City Council positions

Petitions for Hoopeston alderman are now available at Hoopeston City Hall.

Four positions will be voted on in the April 5 election, including four-year terms in all wards and a two-year term in Ward 3. The two-year treasurer position is also up for reelection.

Those currently holding the seats up for reelection include Ed Lotz, Ward 1; Jeff Johnson, Ward 2; Nancy Stipp and Susan Comstock (2 year term) Ward 3; and Brandon Hamilton, Ward 4.

Petitions may be picked up between 7 a.m. and 4 p.m. Monday through Friday, and must be returned

by 4 p.m. Monday, Jan. 31, 2011.

Candidates for other positions, including library trustee, school board and Rossville Village Board, have until December 20 to file the necessary paperwork. Details on each of those races include:

- Candidates running for library trustee may file nominating papers and petitions at Hoopeston Public Library, 110 N. Fourth St., Hoopeston, from December 13-20. Hours are 9:30 a.m.-8 p.m. Monday-Thursday, 9:30 a.m.-6 p.m. Friday and 9:30 a.m. -3 p.m. Saturday.
