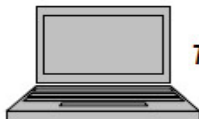

Wagoner ends board tenure, Walder named new president

Mark Wagoner ended his tenure on the Hoopeston Area School Board at a special meeting to canvass election results and seat a new board.

Wagoner served on the board for eight years, as vice president for nearly three years before being chosen as board president four years ago.

"It's been a pleasure working with all of you," he told board members.

Russell Walder was unanimously approved as new board president. Lawrence Jahn was named vice president and Chris Elliott will continue as secretary at an approved salary of \$250 per year.

The newest member, Stewart Coffman, joined newly reelected members Elliott, Chris Small and Mark

Schaumburg in taking the oath of office. Sitting in Wagoner's former seat, Coffman said "I'm sure there's a big pair of shoes under here."

The board also approved the updated policy manual, depositories and meeting dates before going into closed session to discuss collective bargaining.


