Volunteers with heart raise money for transplant recipient

Local people with heart are raising money for a family incurring expenses from a heart transplant.

Andrew Myers, 14, son of Melissa Myers of Hoopeston and James Myers of Alvin, received a heart transplant Wednesday at Children's Memorial Hospital, Chi-

cago.

Andrew, who was born with a heart defect, has had approximately 10 surgeries in his life to try to fix his heart, which grew backwards and upside down, with no

separation wall between the left and right ventricles.
About two weeks ago, he was placed on the heart transplant list, after doctors said a new heart was his only option to live.

On June 26, Andrew returned to the hospital, where he had to stay until a heart was found. The wait ended Wednesday when a donor was found and the transplant performed.

According to reports, Andrew, who will be 15 on July 23, is doing well. However, costs associated with the surgery will be high.

To help offset those costs, two fundraisers have been scheduled so far.

Terra Scharlach and Erika Samet are pre-selling t-shirts, which will be grey with red lettering proclaiming “We (heart) Andrew.”

The second fundraiser, scheduled before the Myers family knew Andrew would receive a transplant, will begin at 10 a.m. Saturday, July 30.
