Fugitive from justice returned to Vermilion County

A fugitive from justice for 19 years is back home in Vermilion County.

Dennis Catron, 60, arrived in Vermilion County early Monday evening, brought to Danville from Los Angeles County, Calif. He was expected to appear in Vermilion County Circuit Court Wednesday.

Catron was arrested in Hoopeston in 1991, after local police alleged he molested a then 13-year-old boy for a period starting in 1990. He skipped bond, then turned himself in. After being released on bond again, Catron fled again, this time, officials believe,

to Bangkok, where he was arrested outside his condominium on June 30.

In 1994, Catron was convicted in absentia of sexually abusing the boy and was sentenced to 12 years in the Department of Corrections on each of three charges.

After his arrest in Bangkok, Catron was sent to Los Angeles County, where, according to unsubstantiated reports, he was erroneously released, then re-apprehended.

A prisoner transport service was used to bring Catron back to Vermilion County.


