## Man's death thought not to be suicide, coroner says

ROSSVILLE—A Hoopeston man who died after being struck by a train on Thursday was not trying to commit suicide, according to Peggy Johnson, Vermilion County coroner.

Johnson said Mr. Rutledge had been walking from one friend's house on the east side of the CSX tracks to where he had been staying on the other side of the tracks. Just before the accident, he was sitting on the east side of the tracks and appeared to be deep in thought. The sound of the train horn startled him, he looked at the train, and, according to the videotape from the train's lead, engine, tried to jump out of the train's path. "It was

definitely not a suicide," she said.

Preliminary autopsy results show Mr. Rutledge died from multiple injuries from being struck by the train on the tracks, Johnson said. A toxicology report is still pending.

The accident occurred early Thursday morning near Green Street. Mr. Rutledge was pronounced dead at 3:05 a.m.

Funeral arrangements for Mr. Rutledge are pending at Anderson Funeral Home, Hoopeston.

Johnson's office and Rossville Police are investigating the accident.
