Historian to present Fallen Soldiers of Vermilion County

In honor of Veterans' Day, local historian Kevin R. Young will conduct a two part workshop, *Fallen Soldiers of Vermilion County*, 1832 - 1918.

Discussion and Power Point presentation will include stories of the first Vermilion County men to die in service of their country from the Black Hawk War of 1832 to World War 1. Hand outs will be provided.

Part 1 will be held at 6 p.m. Tuesday, Nov, 1; part 2 will be at 6 p.m., Tuesday, Nov. 8. Classes will last approximately 90 minutes and will take place in the lobby of the Fischer Theatre.

Young is a writer and research historian with more

than 30 years experience in the field. A graduate of Eastern Illinois University, he is sixth generation Vermilion County resident who lives in Rossville. He is currently working on an illustrated history of the Mexican Army of 1846 - 48.
