## New section of Floral Hill to be surveyed, grave lots set

A new section of Floral Hill Cemetery will be surveyed and marked for new grave lots, following action taken by Hoopeston City Council Tuesday night.

The council unanimously approved spending not more than \$9,435 to Krause Surveying, of Cullom. The fee includes surveying, along with stakes and caps to mark grave lots, said Alderwoman Nancy Stipp, cemetery committee chairwoman. The new section will be comprised of 426 lots, each containing eight grave plots.

In unrelated business, Alderman Bill Goodwine, serving as acting mayor, said he recently toured the new tire recycling business in the former FMC building. "I was

pretty impressed," Goodwine told the council. "Everybody was working. Nobody was standing around. It was the old agricultural community work ethic."

The company repurposes old tires into anchors for tarps to cover grain for dairies and shreds some for use by ADM in Decatur, Goodwine said.

In other business, heard from Alderman Bill McElhane that the city will work with the Lohnes family to provide sewer service and that bids for the Main Street main project will be sought after meetings later this month.
