DACC instructor to present highlights of book at library

Rossville resident Ryan Stone will speak and share highlights from his book, "Best Road Yet," at 10:30 a.m. Saturday, Nov. 26, at Hoopeston Public Library.

Stone, an instructor at Danville Area Community College, recently published the collection of short stories which draw from his childhood experiences living in the southern Missouri Ozarks.

The story series examines the depth of human experience and emotional suffering plaguing small town American. The characters are people who struggle to know and define themselves, as well as to determine the best road on which to travel.

Stone spent much of his youth in Licking, Mo. He published his first short story in 1999 and has been revising and developing the stories for "Best Road Yet" since that time.

He received his bachelor's degree from the University of Central Missouri and his master of fine arts from the University of Missouri-St. Louis. An instructor at DACC since 2006, stone also serves as faculty advisor for the college's student literary publication.
