Children of veterans urged to apply for U of I tuition waivers

State Sen. Shane Cultra (R-Onarga) is reminding students who are the children of veterans to apply for the University of Illinois' Children of Veterans tuition waiver.

This provides a free four-year tuition waiver to any natural or adopted child of a veteran. Up to six waivers per Illinois county are awarded annually, one for each of the following conflicts: World War II, Korean Conflict, Vietnam Conflict, Southeast Asia Conflict, Operation Enduring Freedom and Operation Iraqi Freedom.
