Roof repairs are suspected cause of Sunday building fire

A fire at an empty downtown Hoopeston building is suspected to have started because of roof repairs.

Firemen from Hoopeston, Rossville and Wellington were called at about 7 p.m. Sunday after smoke was seen coming from the roof of the former Kelley's Pub & Grub, 225 E. Main.

Firefighters cut back part of the roof to reach the fire,

which flamed on the southeast side of the roof. Firemen were able to contain the fire to the single building.

Witnesses reported seeing workers on the roof earlier in the day, reportedly repairing the roof with a system that required the roofing material to be heated with a torch.

Hoopeston Police Department and Crosspoint Human Services at the Y are partnering to provide more extensive domestic violence services.

A representative from Crosspoint Human Services at the Y will be available on Wednesdays from 8 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. to meet with victims and survivors from southern Iroquois and northern Vermilion counties at City Hall in Hoopeston.
