

Police investigate baby's death

Hoopeston Police Department is investigating the death of a three-month old Hoopeston boy.

Police Chief Mark Drollinger said his department received a call at 12:17 p.m. Wednesday to the 700 block of east Chestnut for a report of an infant who was not breathing. Police and Hoopeston Ambulance responded. The child, who was in the care of a licensed daycare provider, was taken to Hoopeston Hospital emergency room, where he was pronounced dead.

An autopsy Wednesday showed no signs of trauma, abuse or neglect. Toxicology results are pending.
