Council chooses different electric aggregator than county

Hoopeston officials believe they have found an electric aggregation company that will save residents more than the company providing the same service in Vermilion County.

Integrus, the company chosen by Vermilion County, has a 4.26 cent rate but Good Energy offers a rate as low as 4.1 cents per kilowatt hour, said Alderman Bill Goodwine at Tuesday's Hoopeston City Council meeting.

Goodwine, finance committee chairman, said if an agreement with Good Energy is reached, Hoopeston will join McLean County, Bloomington and other communities in electricity savings.

In order to ink an agreement, the city must get voter approval for electricity aggregation on the April 9 ballot.

If the vote passes residents could save \$200 to \$300 a year by switching, or \$660,000 community-wide, Goodwine said.

Good Energy will assist the city by providing promotional materials about aggregation prior to the election.

If aggregation is approved, Hoopeston will receive a one-one hundredth of a cent per kilowatt hour rebate from New York-based Good Energy. That will total about \$1 per household per month, said Alderman Randy Carter.
