Hoopeston officials voted to move ahead with an agreement with an electric aggregator company.

Hoopeston City Council unanimously approved an agreement with Good Energy at Tuesday night's meet-

Under the agreement, Good Energy will provide proaggregation materials prior to the April 9 election. If aggregation is approved. Good Energy will seek bids for electricity on the city's behalf and bring a proposal to the council which may then accept or reject.

Jerod McMorris, Good Energy consultant, told aldermen many municipalities are signing with Good Energy.

Other area towns where Good Energy has been or expects to be approved include Watseka, Oakwood, Tilton, Catlin, Westville, Ridge Farm, Bloomington, Clinton, Philo and Monticello. "You're in good company with Good Energy," McMorris said.

If electric aggregation measure passes, residents can expect to pay about four cents per kilowatt hour. McMorris said the 4.26 rate with Vermilion County and Integrys agreed to "would have finished last" in a list of recent bids for electric service.




