City approves \$150,000 in motor fuel tax street repairs

Several Hoopeston streets be repaired as part of the city's motor fuel tax program.

Projects will include resurfacing 13 blocks of streets and widening Thompson, from Sixth Ave. to Route 1, said Alderman Randy Carter at Tuesday's Hoopeston City Council meeting.

Additional work is expected to include 10 "fairly significant patches" from water main breaks, including work from Hoopeston Coin Laundry down to the former Hoopeston Electric building and on the north side of the Laundromat and concrete work by the former Kelley's Pub and apron work at the ambu-

lance building.

The council unanimously approved spending no more than \$150,000 on the projects.

Officials will try to come up with an estimated \$37,000 for roadwork at Floral Hill, which cannot be part of motor fuel tax work.

Carter, street/alley committee chairman, said he hopes to save \$65,000-\$70,000 of motor fuel funds for the next few years to help pay to revamp Thompson east to Schumacher's. Between trucks going to the plant and farm machinery coming into Hoopeston, "it's in pretty bad shape," he said.
