

Few contests, combined with referenda questions, comprise ballots voters will use Tuesday.

Hoopeston City Council:

Mayor: Incumbent Bill Crusinberry is challenged by Jeramy Dobkins.

Ward 1: recently appointed Joe Fell, running for a two-year term; incumbent Bill McElhaney, running for four years.

Ward 2: Incumbent Carl Ankenbrand is being challenged by Charles Strawser for a four-year term.

Ward 3: Newcomer Larry Baughn is running unopposed.

Ward 4: Incumbent Bill Goodwine is running unopposed.

Incumbents Edye Bookwalter, treasurer, and city clerk Gail Lane are running unopposed.

Hoopeston Area School District

Incumbents Lisa Leigh, Russell Walder, Lawrence B. Jahn and Stewart Coffman are running unopposed.

Hoopeston Public Library

Sharlynn Miller, Rita Carter and Lori Eells are running for three seats.

Grant Township
