

Dillman Eye Care offers new cataract surgery at CHRHC

Patients treated for cataracts by Dillman Eye Care at Carle Hoopeston Regional Health Center (CHRHC) will now benefit from the latest laser surgery treatment. The femtosecond laser, or LenSX, offers a level of precision in refractive cataract surgery not previously available.

CHRHC has been performing refractive cataract surgeries for 15 years under the direction of David Dillman, MD. (ophthalmology). After construction of a new operating suite in 2012, Dillman Eye Care providers identified the new laser technology, FDA-approved LenSX, they thought could be offered at CHRHC.

"This technology significantly increases the accuracy

of measurements and mapping of the eye critical in planning stages of surgery. In addition, the laser is capable of creating a precise, completely aligned incision every time," said Dr. Dillman. "We are pleased to be one of the first cataract treatment facilities in the nation to offer this technology and look forward to adopting more leading treatments to benefit our patients."

This is the first time a femtosecond laser has been made available on a mobile unit, allowing small hospitals like CHRHC to access the technology, which not only allows for more effective cataract removal but also addresses the refractive status of the eye; patients are seeing a more natural vision and have reported not needing their eyeglasses as often.

SightPath Medical recently filmed Dillman Eye Care providers at work in a Carle Hoopeston operating suite and will use that footage to teach both patients and providers how the technology works.

"This laser is one of many incredible options for patients that have come as a result of the integration with Carle and the longstanding relationship with Dillman Eye Care," said Misti Morfey, RN, CHRHC surgical department manager. "We are excited to be able to pro-
