

### Relative of local men killed in plane crash in Afghanistan

A Louisville, Ky., man—half-brother of two Hoopeston men—has been identified as one of seven Americans killed in a plane crash in Afghanistan.

Timothy Garrett, 51, died when the plane they were on crashed shortly after takeoff.

Among his survivors are two half-brothers, Joe and LT Garrett, of Hoopeston, as well as two daughters, ages 11 and 12, of Indiana.

According to published reports, Mr. Garrett, along with six Michigan people, died April 29 when a Boeing 747-400, operated by National Air Cargo, crashed after takeoff from Bagram Air Base near Kabul, Afghanistan.

The plane was owned by National Airlines, a Florida



subsidiary of National Air Cargo and was bound for Dubai, carrying vehicles and other cargo.

The Taliban claimed responsibility for the crash but NATO representatives said those claims were false. The cause of the crash is still under investigation.

Mr. Garrett was a maintenance crewman; others killed were also employees of the company. They include: Gary Stockdale, 51, of the Detroit area; pilots Brad Hasler, 34, of Trenton, Mich., and Jeremy Lipka, 37, of Brooklyn, Mich.; first officer Rinku Summan, 32, of Canton, Mich.; loadmaster Michael Sheets, 36, of Ypsilanti, Mich.; and Jamie Brokaw, 33, of Monroe, Mich.
