Group gets donation to award college-bound wrestlers

The governing board of a local scholarship program aims to provide financial help to Hoopeston Area wrestlers who plan to attend a four-year college.

The board overseeing the Dan Magee Memorial Wrestling Tournament are using funds from the tournament, as well as other donations, to provide scholarships, said Jed Rayls, spokesman for the organization.

The board plans to offer a \$500 scholarship for each of the four years a Hoopeston Area wrestler attends the






