# It's out! Firemen go, cleanup crews come at site of tire fire

After commanding the attention of 24 fire departments, a fire which began Wednesday was declared officially out on Friday.

Hoopeston Fire Chief Cliff Crabtree said Friday that firemen had stopped putting water on debris from the fire at J&R Tire Recycling, in the former FMC Building. With the fire out, crews can now begin cleanup.

Fire officials turned over control of the site to J&R owners, who hired contractors. Sunday, with areas of smoke still rising from the ashes, those contractors erected a fence around the property to keep trespassers out.

The Illinois EPA on Friday was still working to clean up water runoff from fire fighting efforts. The EPA is also expected to announce this week whether large pieces of ash are considered hazardous material.

Firemen were called to the scene at 5:20 a.m. Wednesday for the fire, which state fire officials said started with static electricity in the area where employees were working. Flames spread quickly through the building, which stretches from Maple to Orange St. (Route 9).

It was on Wednesday when Mayor Bill Crusinberry and Scott Strawser, Hoopeston Emergency Management Agency (EMA) coordinator, declared a state of emergency for the southwest part of the city.

Crusinberry said he was advised by an Illinois EMA official to declare the state of emergency, which suspends a few normal government functions. For example, it allowed Crusinberry to sign for \$200,000 of foam concentrate to fight the fire.

Normally, the city must get bids on items estimated to cost more than \$10,000 and such expenditures must have council approval.
