Barickman gets burger served with concealed carry, jobs

Illinois 53rd District Sen. Jason Barickman (R-Bloomington) stopped by Mr. B's Café Tuesday to speak with Hoopeston residents. His cheeseburger lunch was peppered with questions concerning concealed carry, jobs and other issues.

Sam Browne came to see Barickman about Illinois' recently-passed concealed carry law, suggesting veterans be allowed to carry concealed because their backgrounds have already been checked via the Firearm Owners Identification (FOID) card process and firearms training received in the military.

Saying Browne made valid points, Barickman talked about the gap in viewpoints between downstate senators and those in the Chicago area when it comes to firearms. For exam-

ple. Barickman and fellow downstate senators tried to get reciprocity included in the law, where someone allowed to carry concealed in his home state would also
