Carle rural health center offers free first aid, CPR classes

The Center for Rural Health and Farm Safety at Carle is offering free first aid and CPR courses in Hoopeston on Monday, Oct. 7 at Hoopeston First Church of God, 1012 E. Orange St.

From 9:30 a.m.-noon, American Heart Association HeartSaver First Aid certification followed by American Heart Association HeartSaver CPR certification with AED, from 12:30 - 4 p.m.

Participants may attend one or both of the classes.

According to the American Heart Association, 80 percent of cardiac arrests occur at home and are witnessed by a family member. Cardiovascular diseases are

the number one cause of death in the United States. Unintentional injuries are the fifth leading cause of death, just behind chronic diseases. CPR and First Aid training may save your life, or the life of someone you love.

Topics for CPR will include infant, child and adult choking and CPR as well as Automatic External Defibrillator (AED) use. The First Aid course will cover how to recognize and treat injuries, use appropriate equipment and supplies, and respond to various emergencies.

Courses will include hands-on instruction and a workbook. For each class successfully completed, partici-
