Adjusted scoring helps Honeywell, Maple meet standards

Honeywell and Maple grade schools made adequate yearly progress (AYP) on 2013 ISAT testing because of a scoring variable.

Under the variable, "Safe Harbor," the state, a district or school that fails to make AYP outright qualifies if "subgroups each subgroup that fails to reach its proficiency performance targets reduces its percentage of students not meeting standards by 10% of the previous year's percentage, plus the subgroup must meet the attendance rate or graduation rate targets," according to the Illinois State Board of Education website.

To attain AYP, 92.5 percent of students had to meet or (Prairie State Achievement Exam) in the high school.

At Honeywell, 66.3 percent of all students met or exceeded the Safe Harbor target of 60.2 percent in reading and 62.1 percent met or exceeded math standards, where the Safe Harbor level was 58.4.

Maple School's standing is tied to Honeywell's, so

John Greer and Hoopeston Area Middle School are each in the first year of Academic Early Warning after failing to make AYP.

At John Greer, 57.3 students met the Safe Harbor target of 57.4 percent in reading. However, the 65.3 percent math target was not reached, with only 49.7 percent of students meeting or exceeding math standards.

HAMS students failed to make AYP in reading and bath, with 41.6 percent of students meeting reading standards and 46.1 percent in math, compared with safe Harbor targets of 55 percent and 53.7 percent, respectively.
